We are a Farsi speaking congregation, and primarily composed of new immigrants—including many Muslim converts to Christianity. We meet in North Vancouver, BC, at Sutherland Church near Hillside Baptist Church. Hillside staff are walking with Pastor Arash in mentorship, accountability and relationship.

Arash has a strong calling to share the Good News of the kingdom of God to all who will hear. He serves wholeheartedly and has a true pastor's heart. He is also using Skype to pastor two churches in Turkey.

Arash has laboured in this work for five years without compensation, choosing instead to work full time in his job until he could no longer do so. He is currently living off his savings, though that will not carry him much longer.

second congregation in
Coquitlam. Close to half of our
current North Vancouver
congregation are from the
Coquitlam area and most new
Farsi speaking immigrants
resettle there.

IDEAL SUPPORT FUNDING FOR SUSTAINABLE MINISTRY

YEAR 1: Up to \$15,000 for leader assessment, training and CBWC integration

YEAR 2: Up to \$50,000 for staffing and neighbourhood integration

YEAR 3: Up to \$50,000 for staffing and ministry costs

YEAR 4: Up to \$35,000 for staffing and ministry, as congregational tithes increase

YEAR 5: Up to \$15,000 for leader assessment, training and development of second plant (ie, Year 1 of second plant)

TOTAL POTENTIAL 5-YEAR INVESTMENT: \$165,000
